### PEC Showing

Here at Providence there are many showing opportunities that fit each rider's experience, goals, level of commitment, horse suitability, and budget. We host barn shows and attend "B" and "C" rated shows. We have a qualified staff to help find an appropriate lease or purchase of a horse or pony for these show opportunities and can also lease our own academy horses.

STONEHAVEN 's nationally acclaimed trainer and resident professional, **Todd Wisegarver**, offers his experience and expertise to the rider showing at A rated shows. Stonehaven offers comprehensive services from finding the right horse for each rider, to lessons, and show preparation. Combine this with training and conditioning of the equine athlete, riders enjoy well prepared horses and much success in the show ring.

## Lesson Descriptions

**Beginner I-** Learn to safely approach, halter, and lead a horse, Learn to groom, tack, mount, and dismount, Introduce riding aids, learn correct riding position and balance exercises. Introduce trotting and the concept of diagonals. Learn the two-point position and posting at the trot. Practice utilizing riding aids in steering exercises. Enjoy trail rides.

**Beginner II -** Know parts of the tack, continue working on diagonals, begin pole work. Introduce the sitting trot and strengthen two-point position. Improve use of all riding aids, steering and gait transitions. Learn to canter and enjoy trail riding.

**Beginner III-** Tack independently, increase strength, balance, and body position at walk, trot, canter, and two-point position. Introduction to no stirrup work at the walk and trot. Strengthen and improve the use of all riding aids. Begin cantering individually. Introduction to leads. Develop ability and confidence in working pole patterns, Introduce the use of rhythm and stride counting.

**Intermediate I-** Work on transitions. Know leads and expand the use of riding aids, including leg yielding, half halting, and leg-to-hand connection. Introduce collection and extension at the canter. Continue to work on cross rails and jumping small solids. Begin course work and improve stride counting.

**Intermediate II-** Develop clear understanding and execution of circles, serpentines, and figure eights, continue transition work, develop leg-to-land and apply to course work, improve counting, balance, position, and strength over fences, jumping to 2'3".

**Advanced-** Continue position strengthening. Apply prior knowledge to higher jump heights. Master and execute flying lead changes. Develop consistent balance and rhythm in coursework. Master ability to alter stride length on the flat and in coursework. Utilize all aids to maximize responsiveness and rideability. Individually tailored instruction is available for advancing equestrians based on their riding goals in hunt seat, jumping, and equitation disciplines.

## Policies

**School Year Tuition Policies-** Tuition is based on a **40-lesson** school year session and is

Divided into monthly payments. August tuition is due on or before August 22, 2022, and is half of the monthly tuition. September through June is due by the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. June tuition will be half the monthly tuition.

Tuition may be mailed, dropped in the payment box, or automatically debited from a Visa, MasterCard, or Discover charge card left on file.

**Summer tuition Policies-** Tuition is based on a **9-week session** and is due on or before June 12, 2023.

**Late fee- If tuition is received after the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month,** there is a **\$25 late fee** charge. To avoid late fees and ensure timely payments, credit card information may be provided, and tuition will be automatically debited on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month.

**Discounts-** There is a **\$10 discount** applied to every family's second monthly lesson. The discount for the summer session is **\$20**.

**Lesson Withdrawal-**In order to notify the barn of withdrawal and cease responsibility for payment of services, a **four-week written notice** must be submitted. Accounts must be settled at the time of withdrawal.

**Make-Up Lessons** -Students are encouraged to attend all classes. Two make up lessons are allowed per session.

To be eligible for a makeup, the barn must be notified 48 hours in advance of the scheduled lesson time.

There are no make-ups offered for lessons in which the barn was not notified of an absence. There are no make ups for make up lessons. There are no makeup lessons offered for the reason of inclement weather unless the barn cancels lessons due to weather. All classes paid for in the School Year Session must be attended by June 10, 2023.

**Horse Assignments-** These are based on rider suitability as well as lesson plans and are up to the sole discretion of the instructor. However, make sure and let your instructor know which of our school horses are your favorites! Remember- It benefits every rider to ride many different horses.

**Unmounted Lessons-** PEC will hold up to two unmounted lessons during the session. Material presented in these lessons is a valuable part of a rider's education.

Weather make ups will only be granted if lessons are cancelled by PEC.

## Show Policies

All show service bills are due at the time of invoicing and are considered late after 5 days. Late payments are subject to a \$50 fee. Providence Equestrian does not assume responsibility for damage or loss of personal belongings at shows. If a rider is unable to attend an away show that has been committed to, the barn must be notified no later than the posted cancellation date or the rider will be responsible for a groom fee per show day, the professional expense split, coaching minimum, and any payments required by the show. All transportation of horses owned by Providence will be provided by Providence. A list of show fees is available upon request.

## Leasing and Boarding

When you make the decision to buy or lease a horse or pony, the professionals at Providence Equestrian Center are here to help. We have matched up many successful horse and rider teams already, and their results speak for themselves! Boarding at Providence offers every owner the peace of mind that their horse receives the highest quality care under veterinary supervision in a safe, well managed facility. Complete with a professional groom staff and state of the art arenas, horse owners have everything they need at Providence to protect their investment and enjoy excellence in performance.

**Horse Leasing- Riders must be concurrently enrolled in lessons at PEC.**

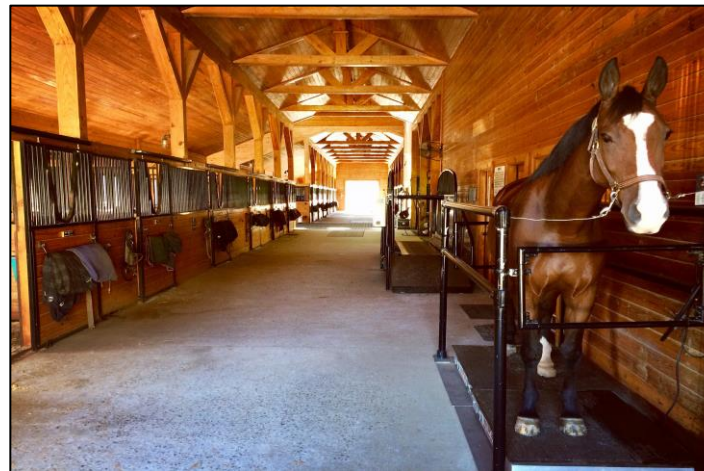
**Academy Leasing** is available on a few of our horses. The fee is \$800 per month and allows the rider to ride 3 times per week, inclusive of lesson days.

**Half Leases** are available and priced individually. A minimum 6-month lease term is required. Lessees assume ½ of all board, veterinary, farrier, husbandry, and insurance expenses.

**Full Leases** are available and priced individually. Full leases are responsible for 100% of all expenses. A 15% commission is applied to all outside leases.

## Boarding

**\$1650/month** Board services include cleaning the stall throughout the day, feed and water, hay 3-4 times per day, turn out, blanketing as weather dictates, feeding supplied supplements, administering medications, hand walking in inclement weather, grooming, laundry, and arranging for farrier and other services. Training services included in this board are treadmilling, pessoning, longing, and up to 3 training rides per week. **Additional rides are billed at \$50/ride.** Treatments included in this board are hoof packing, prophylactic hoof treatments, wrapping, poulticing, medicated baths, icing, and soaking, and minor wound treatment. **A supply fee of \$80 will be charged to each boarder quarterly.** Tacking service is available upon request during established hours. **Absentee owner board is \$2200/month.**
